Acceptance Criteria:

- Internship request letter from Intern's sponsor
- Saudi national or born from Saudi mother only
- Graduate from Bachelor's Degree on the same field
- Currently enrolled in a recognized Cardiovascular Technology or Equivalent Program
- GPA (minimum 3.5)
- Valid English Qualification eg. IELTS (minimum score 4.5 overall or equivalent)

Duration:

- Nine months.

Three (3) months in each rotation in: Adult Echo, Pediatric Echo, and Electrophysiology

Benefits:

- Medical coverage as per hospital policy.
- Certificate of completion.

Fees:

- 1,500 SAR per month (excluding 15% VAT).
