Program Overview:

The Emergency Medical Technician - Advanced apprenticeship program is designed to equip trainees with the advanced skills and knowledge required to provide standard advance life support in emergency medical situations. The program objectives encompass a range of advanced skills and knowledge areas. Trainees will learn and demonstrate safe lifting and moving techniques to ensure the safety of both patients and providers during transportation and transfers. They will also develop the ability to interpret vital signs, including 12-lead ECG, enabling them to assess and monitor the cardiac status of patients.

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Advanced airway management is a crucial aspect of emergency medical care. Trainees will gain the skills to apply oxygen masks, including bag valve masks, effectively to provide necessary respiratory support.

They will also learn the basics of emergency medical pharmacology, understanding the appropriate use and administration of medications in emergency situations.

Interpreting vital signs according to ambulance services protocols will be a key focus. Trainees will learn the specific parameters and guidelines for assessing vital signs, such as blood pressure, heart rate, respiratory rate, oxygen saturation, and interpret them accurately to make informed clinical decisions.

The program will also cover the preparation of treatment plans according to the paramedic scope of practice. Trainees will acquire the knowledge and skills to prioritize and administer appropriate interventions based on patient conditions and established protocols.

- Demonstrate Transport Patients safely to Emergency Department
- Produce endorsement to other health care providers
