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Acceptance Criteria:

- Internship request letter from Intern's sponsor
- Saudi national or born from Saudi mother only
- GPA 3 out of 5 and above
- Passing KFSH&RC English placement test

Duration:

- Five months

Five (5) weeks in each rotation – (Total of 4 rotations)
