Program Overview:

The Optometry Internship at King Faisal Specialist Hospital & Research Centre (KFSH&RC) provides interns an excellent training experience in a full scope clinical setting. Interns gain experience, knowledge and skills in key optometry topics eg. Refraction, effective communication with patient, history taking, slit lamp examination, tonometry and other routine diagnostic procedures.

Program Objectives:

By the end of the training, participants will:

- Measure refractive errors of eye to determine proper prescription of eyeglasses for children and adults
- Demonstrate knowledge of fitting, evaluating, prescribing and distributing different types of contact lenses
- Describe psychological and social rehabilitation of the visually impaired using visual aids
- Apply optometry skills such as slit lamp examination and tonometry during diagnostic procedures

- Internship request letter from Intern's sponsor
- Saudi national or born from Saudi mother only
- GPA 3.75 out of 5 and above
- Pass the interview
- Completed 10 semesters of Doctor of Optometry (OD) Program
- Others (Will accept 2nd Or 3rd rotation only)
