- Interpret adult and pediatric clinical swallowing evaluation results
- Discuss adult and pediatric dysphagia assessments & findings with other medical professionals, patients and family
- Summarize adult and pediatric swallowing and feeding disorders treatment plan
- Conduct adult and pediatric instrumental dysphagia assessment procedures
- Explain adult & pediatric communication disorders
- Explain adult and pediatric communication assessment strategies and tests
- Discuss adult and pediatric communication disorders assessments & findings with other medical professionals, patients and family
- Summarize adult and pediatric communication disorders treatment plan
- Demonstrate professional report writing skills
- Develop treatment programs for patients

- Internship request letter from Intern's sponsor
- Saudi national or born from Saudi mother only
- GPA 4 out of 5 or 3 out of 4 and above
- Name of Academic or Equivalent Qualifications required
- English Proficiency Exam (STEP) score of 85+/100
- Pass the interview
